


WHAT IS A KINDNESS KIT?

A Kindness Kit is a captivating red box full of carefully thought-out items (selected by Connor) that addresses the critical need to support children facing adversity, including medical issues, housing insecurity, and traumatic life events. Kindness Kits are a vital resource for children facing these challenging circumstances, offering comfort, hope, and a sense of support during their most vulnerable moments. Kits are curated with trendy, entertaining, educational, and comforting items, such as a mini Lego sets, Bombas socks, an Etch A Sketch, Play-Doh, slime, crayons, a coloring book, a card game, stickers, a Rubik's Cubes, MadLlibs and Pop-Its. The kit provides emotional relief by alleviating the stress of a challenging situation and fosters resilience. They are delivered to 70 plus partner organizations in New England for distribution.

HOW CAN I GET INVOLVED?

There are plenty of ways to contribute to our Kindness Kit program. You can volunteer in our Woburn office and assemble Kindness Kits yourself (or with friends), set up a team building event at your workplace to build Kits together, purchase an item from our Amazon Wishlist, or make a donation to the program. Every \$25 supports one Kindness Kit.





KIDS KINDNESS CLUB



WHAT IS THE KIDS KINDNESS CLUB?

The Kids Kindness Club is an educational enrichment program designed to foster empathy, inclusivity, and social-emotional learning among elementary-age children. Launched in January 2023, this initiative introduces students to community service while encouraging them to be mindful of others' feelings and well-being. By engaging in activities that promote kindness and inclusion, participants develop essential life skills that serve as a proactive approach to preventing bullying without explicitly using these terms.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

For a modest fee, each school who participates in Kids Kindness Club will receive: a CKP support liaison to design implementation, a live in-person assembly for the program launch, kindness books for the school library, and a 48x63 kindness coloring poster. Each participant takes a Kindness Pledge and completes 20 Acts of Kindness from a provided list within a timeframe set by their school or classroom. These simple, meaningful activities—such as writing thoughtful notes to others, donating items, volunteering, or helping a classmate or neighbor are designed to encourage children to make compassion a habit. Upon completion, students will receive a Kindness Certificate, and a Kindness is My Superpower sticker, reinforcing their commitment to making a difference and being thoughtful about others.






